Dear Neighbor:

We are writing to tell you about your local fire company the Penn Forest Volunteer Fire Company No. 2, located right across from the Indian Mountain Lake development at 1507 Route 534. Our volunteer firefighters are the first responders for your local communities and in mutual aid calls in Kidder Township, Jim Thorpe Borough, Monroe County, and many more! Some of the communities we respond directly to include Towamensing Trails, Valley View Estates, Mount Pocahontas, Jonas Mountain Estates, Hickory Run Forest, Stone Ridge Estates, and Indian Mountain Lakes. In addition to fires, we respond to motor vehicle accidents, medical emergencies, aero medical landings, search and rescues, water rescues, and we are also an emergency shelter. Our first responders proudly dedicate themselves to serving the community, but we rely on the support of each and every one of you to provide the best service we can. Your support does not go unnoticed! Last year, our officers and truck committee worked hard to complete a rehab project on our brush unit including new truck and hose beds, new hose reel for faster and easier deployment, and upgraded lights. Our ladder truck, acquired last year, has also been completely outfitted and has proven to be an asset to the township and surrounding areas.

In June our volunteers held their second annual Camp Cadet program for children ages 10-14. The program is designed to introduce kids to emergency services in the community. During our weekend long day camp, kids participated in training exercises in vehicle rescue, fire extinguishers and firehoses, were able to familiarize themselves with the fire trucks and equipment, and even got CPR certified! Volunteers from the Pennsylvania State Police and Lehigh ambulance also stopped by to teach the kids about police and EMS responses. Keep an eye out for more information regarding Camp Cadet sign ups this Spring.

Although many fire companies struggle with manpower, our community continues to come together, and our firefighter family continues to grow! However, with all growth, we encounter additional expenses for gear, equipment, tools, and training. Each firefighter is required to complete a minimum of 160 hours of training. This helps us ensure that our responders are competently trained in their skills and knowledge and can safely respond to all emergency dispatches they may encounter. As members/residents, you may already be aware of our successful social club fundraiser for the fire department. The Firehouse Grill is located within the firehouse building and holds many community events throughout the year. These events include, but are not limited to, live entertainment and shows, Friday night dinners for the whole family, holiday activities with children, and various bar leagues and games throughout the week, and are available to the whole community.
